ADVERB	PREPOSITION	CONJUNCTION	INTERJECTION
Describes or modifies a verb, adjective or adverb; tells where, how, when, or to what extent	Shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another word	Joins two words, ideas, or phrases together; shows how they are connected	A word or phrase that expresses a strong feeling or emotion
Slowly, fast, well, extremely, suddenly, late, carefully	Across, below, until, towards, within, over, above, before	Or, because, either, neither, but, while, however, since	Wow! Help! No! Great! Hey! Hello! Ouch! Yahoo!
